

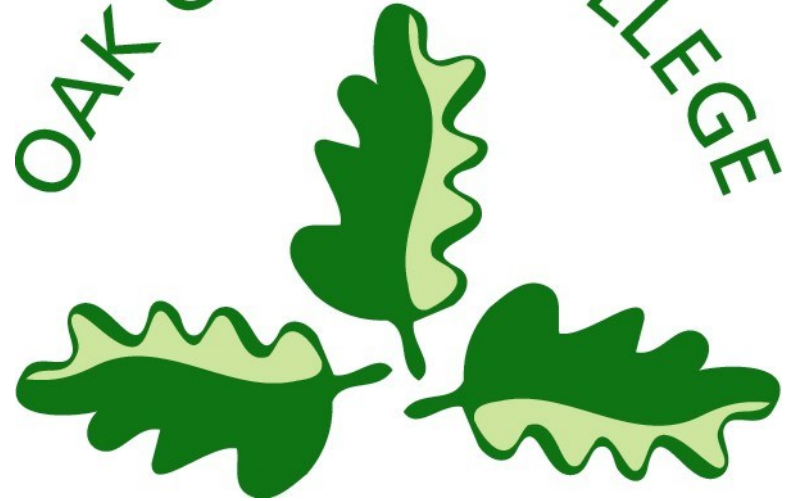
Activities to support learning at home
