Cornfield School is for boys with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. Some of the projects the schools are looking to fund are; a music technology room, wheelchair accessible play equipment, a sensory soft play room, a teaching kitchen and a rebound therapy centre.

Important things to remember for Gift Aid

- Remind your sponsors that Gift Aid means UK taxpayers can add an extra 25% to their sponsorship at no extra cost to them
- Make sure your sponsor writes their full name, home address and postcode on the form so we can claim Gift Aid. Please note we cannot claim Gift Aid from business addresses or multiple donors, e.g. Mr & Mrs Smith.
- The form must be completed in their own handwriting.
